Treasurer's Report: Accepted as read. Report not available at this time. It was also reported that there would be a return of \$150 from the \$400 given for the teacher's appreciation breakfast.

Principal's Report: Reported by Andy Fiorentino

It was stated that this has been a busy time for the Middle School. The awards ceremony went very well, with the only area awards were not able to be given was band because M. PATS sponsored the 8th grade dance and graduation ceremony. An executive decision was made to give an additional \$200 for expenses.
